This afternoon we will have time to hike and explore the area. For the next three (3) nights you will be staying in a local area hotel in Rio de Janerio. All accommodation is based on hotels with twin rooms (occasional triple) with private facilities guaranteed throughout. Tonight, dinner is included (Pizza Party).
Monday, June 17	Rio de Janerio	This morning you will have breakfast in the hotel. After a delicious breakfast in your hotel, you will head out on a trip to see the world-

UC will head out on a trip to see the worldfamous Christ the Redeemer statue on top of Corcovado Mountain. A specially designed and environmentally friendly train will take you from the foot of the mountain along a winding road through the magical Tijuca rainforest where if you are lucky, you can see some of the enchanting tropical wildlife on constant display in Rio, such as toucans, monkeys and armadillos. At the summit of Corcovado, 800m above sea level, proudly stands the iconic image seen around the world - a 38m high statue of Christ the Savior. But that is not the only breathtaking thing about this place -you will overwhelmed by the stunnina panoramic view of the city, so high up it seems as though you are truly flying with the birds around you. From the far reaches of Guanabara Bay, to the Maracana Stadium, Sugarloaf alona to Mountain, Copacabana, Ipanema Gávea and

After descending by cable car, we have a bit of free time for hiking, to spend on the beach and dinner on our own.

- Tonight, you will return to your hotel in Rio de Janerio.
- This morning you will have breakfast in the hotel. Before checking out and continuing your adventures to Campo Grande and the Pantanal.
- Transfer to the airport, flight Pantanal. Transfer to hotel.
- Another memorable day awaits us! We take a flight to Campo Grande where our driver is waiting for us. Pantanal is located in the center of the South American continent. This is a unique world conservation area located in Brazil. Wetland covered with dense flowering vegetation is the main landscape of the area. Here, lakes and rivers with crystal clear water provide shelter for the rarest specimens of birds and animals. Travelers stay in small, modern lodges which provide complete comfort convenience. The Pantanal is for nature lovers, scientists, fishermen, photographers,

Thursday, June 20 Pantanal

- This morning you will have breakfast in the hotel.
- Today we participate in the tours mentioned above as we explore Pantanal. The trips are carefully selected to make the most of your time and depend on the climate and time of year. All are guided by locals that will share information about the flora and fauna. To avoid the intense heat of midday, most tours will be early in the morning and later in the afternoon and the possibility of seeing the movement of more animals is improved.
- Today, Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner are included.

Friday, June 21

Pantanal & Bonito

- This morning you will have breakfast in the hotel.
- Early morning departure towards the Bodoquena Mountain Range, brings us to Parque das Cahciueiras waterfalls where we have a tour. Here a walk across the preserved woodland along safe trails will take you to seven waterfalls, of which beautiful caves hide behind the wall of water. Indulge in the translucent natural pools and refresh yourself in the transparent

crystal-clear river. Pause to observe the woodlands and the huge limestone walls. After getting so much from nature, it's time to return to the reception area. The afternoon can be spent at the natural swimming pools before heading to Bonito and check in at our hotel.

Today Breakfast and Lunch are included and Dinner is on your own.

Saturday, June 22 Bonito

This morning you will have breakfast in the hotel.

🏽 After breakfast, we visit the Gruta do Lago Azul. The trail will start with a 40-minute walk to the cave, then, after descending 100 meters, you will see the lake with its crystalclear water. The depth is 72 meters and, in the morning, when the sunbeams hit the lake, the water will have an intense blue color. In late morning we continue to the Rio Sucuri, where lunch will be served. After lunch we start our snorkeling tour. The tour starts with a visit to the river spring, where you can see the water boiling out of the ground. You are taken to a wooden deck where you start the snorkeling tour along the crystal-clear river. The 750- meter-long trip you can observe the rich subaquatic flora and fauna. It is an unforaettable experience. For those who do not want to go snorkeling, it's possible to stay in the boat and descend the river by support boat and enjoy the flora and fauna at the river edges. (B, L)
